Camping Rules & Information

- * Upon arrival, all campers must register with our Administration Office or your designated group coordinator. You will receive an identification card.
- * Please display the proper camping identification card or proof of payment on your camping unit.
- * Pets are permitted, but must be on a leash when not in the RV unit
- * Owners **MUST** clean up after their pet
- * **NO OPEN FIRES** See attached form for details
- * Individual camping sites must be kept clean at all times
- * One vehicle per site
- * Washing of any vehicle is prohibited
- * Please utilize the designated Dumping Stations. (1 single & 1 double)
- * Positively NO sewage or water may be run on the ground (State Law)
- * Violators will be prosecuted
- * NO Skateboarding
- * NO Roller blades
- * Bike riding is permitted on the grounds; helmets are required for children
- * Each Rally attendee will need at least 50' of water hose and a "Y" connector to hook up to shared water
- * Each Rally attendee will need at least 50' of S/O cord capable of handling a minimum of 20 amps/120 volts

Fire and Emergency Service

General Guidelines for Recreational Fires and the use of Chimeneas or Factory Built Novelty Stoves

- Recreational fires are permitted while using a chimenea or factory built novelty stove. Homemade fire pits or stoves are NOT permitted for use.
- A recreational fire may be used on a private single family dwelling lot. Use at a townhome, condominium, or apartment is NOT permitted.
- All recreational fires shall be attended at all times and must be extinguished at dusk. No open burning is permitted after sunset.
- The chimenea or stove must be on a noncombustible surface – brick, stone, or concrete. Bare ground is permitted if void of dry grass or other combustible ground cover.
- All recreational fires shall be a minimum of 15 feet from any structure including decks, sheds, or fences.
- Only cured firewood, charcoal, natural gas, or propane gas may be used.
- Yard waste, leaves, grass clippings, or garden waste may NOT be burned.
- Smoke from a recreational fire may not create a hazard or nuisance. If smoke does pose a hazard or nuisance, the recreational fire shall be extinguished and the privilege suspended.

SAFETY AND SECURITY INFORMATION

- **LOCATION – York Fairgrounds 334 Carlisle Ave. in WEST MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP**
- Be prepared to identify the Building you are in or the location and description of your camp site.

Our on-duty Police Officers will respond to ALL emergency and non-emergency calls for assistance. Our officers are trained first responders and can provide immediate assistance. **We are here to serve you, help you, and keep you safe.** Please don't hesitate to call us.

- Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
- Report any crimes or suspicious activity immediately, **DO NOT WAIT** for something to happen, **CALL RIGHT AWAY!**
- Become familiar with your area whether it is in a building, parking lot, or camp site.
- Be on the lookout for / report any people or vehicles in the camper areas that don't belong there.
- Be on the alert for people who are acting unusual or suspicious, (heavy coat on a hot day, etc.).
- Be on the alert for people carrying unusually large backpacks or packages.
- Be aware and on the lookout for suspicious or abandoned packages, objects, bags, or packages.

If you encounter any of the above situations, follow this procedure:

- Report the location and description of the situation to Fair Police immediately....**DO NOT WAIT**
- If you do not see an officer in the immediate area, call the phone number above....**DO NOT WAIT**
- Stay clear of any suspicious objects, persons, or situations until they have been properly checked out.

Many serious, dangerous problems can be prevented if the Police are called quickly. We would rather get calls that turn out to be nothing as opposed to not getting a call of a serious problem. If we all work together as a team, we can ensure that the York Expo Center will be a safe, enjoyable, environment for us all.
