- 1. Step to side of chair correctly – opening – turns 90 degrees and faces WM 2 _____
- 2. Respond to WM & properly handles badge (nods each time to WM) 2 _____
- 3. Opening Prayer stands beside chair, follows North Marching Line to West ML, turns and approaches Altar on diagonal line, assumes Reverent Attitude after music stops. 2 _____
- 4. After prayer, drops Reverent Attitude, takes one step back, turns toward Martha, and takes place in the Circle of Officers and faces Altar. 2 _____
- 5. "Obeyed" is the cue for Chaplain to take one step back, turn left, goes to NW ML turns East and returns to station. 2 _____
- 6. Closing Prayer – follow Nos. 3 and 4. 4 _____
- 7. When the WM declares the Chapter "Closed", she removes Badge. 2 _____
- 8. When the Warder says "Closed", the Chaplain returns to station as in No. 5. 2 _____
